

New Community Eye Service for **Capelfield Patients**

The community service can treat people experiencing the following common minor eye problems:

- Eve pain
- Red or sore eyes or eyelids
- Dry, gritty or uncomfortable eyes
- Irritated or inflamed eyes
- Watery eyes or sticky discharge from the eye
- Flashes or floaters in the eye

- Ingrowing eyelashes,
- Suddenly reduced vision,
- Foreign body in the eye (e.g. small piece of grit or wood),
- Excessive tears.
